### Background



- June 10, 2024 City Council adopted the Biennial Budget for Fiscal Years 2024 - 2026
- November 11, 2024 Quarter 1 Budget Update was approved
  - Revenue projections increased by \$385,600
  - Expenditures increased by \$292,522
  - Net position resulted in an increase of \$93,078 to the General Fund
- March 10, 2025 Mid-Year Budget Update was approved
  - Revenue projections increased by \$984,878
  - Expenditures increased by \$490,011
  - Net position resulted in an increase of \$729,637 to the General Fund
    - This amount was reserved towards one-time expenditures

### Background

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- April 28, 2025, departments presented FY 2025-26 reductions / revenue increases totaling \$676,306
  - Council requested that staff maintain PD jail transportation contract
  - Other reductions were found
- Revised FY 2025-26 reductions / revenue increases total \$520,726

# **Updated FY 2025-26 Revenue Projections**



Sales Tax (\$1,597,496)

Property Tax \$311,709

Interest Income \$700,000

TOTAL REVENUE DECREASE (\$585,787)

All other revenues remain as budgeted

Use of Reservation for PD (\$200,000)

Usage of Designated Reserves (\$420,000)

#### FY 2025-26 Personnel Changes



- Add 1 Management Analyst position
  - Use salary from existing part-time position to partially fund a Management Analyst
  - No impact to General Fund
- Reclassify the Senior Accounting Technician position to a Principal Accounting Technician
